

First CALL FOR PAPERS

The 2nd International Symposium on Recent Advances in Vortex-Induced Vibrations (ISVIV2022) will be held on **Oct. 22-23, 2022** in **Chengdu, China**. ISVIV2022 is aiming to provide a dedicated and unique forum for international researchers who have been contributing to VIV research, to exchange state-of-the-art ideas, and establish/consolidate research collaborations.



ISVIV will be organized into single plenary sessions with **invited lectures (40 minutes)**, **oral presentation (25 minutes)** and **poster presentations** together with a networking activity among participants. The symposium will be in English.

TOPICS (including but not limited to)

- Vortex-induced vibrations of bluff bodies
- Vortex-induced vibrations of long flexible cylinders
- Wake/proximity interference between multiple bodies
- Energy harvesting from vortex-induced vibrations
- Vortex-induced rotations of bluff bodies
- Vortex-induced vibration suppressions

The selected abstracts will be invited to submit an extended version for journal papers that will be peer-reviewed and collected into **Applied Ocean Research (APOR)**.
